

Railway Noise Control 2007 - Seminar 6: Evolution of Railway Noise Control

Catherine Leung has been working in the environmental engineering field in the railway industry over 9 years. She is the environmental engineer with the Operations Division of the MTR and has been responsible for various noise improvement projects for the Operating Railway from noise barriers to wheel rail interface noise control. She currently involves in Tung Chung and Tsing Yi noise barriers construction project, noise control through better grinding and friction improvement at wheel rail interface, etc. In this seminar, she will share her experience in railway noise control from the evolution of noise enclosures and barrier to control at sources. She will review factors affecting railway noise and possible ways to mitigate from re-design, operate and maintenance.
