

Railway Noise Control 2007 - Seminar 7: A Manufacturer's Overview on Attenuation of Railway Track Noise

Speaker: Dr Trevor R. Smith of Tiflex Ltd

Trevor read mechanical engineering at Nottingham University and continued there to research into the fatigue properties of glass reinforced plastics. He commenced his career with developing plastic gas pipe systems and in subsequent career moves, he, being a self styled 'materials engineer', has retained an interest in pipeline technology and developing a particular interest in the use of elastomeric materials for seals. This has lead to greater involvement in the use of resilient elastomeric materials in railway applications. This is a long way from Trevor's first experience of servicing the railway industry which was in the design and supply of cast iron and ductile iron tunnel lining segments, including involvement with the early stages of the Island route for MTR. For the past 10 years, Trevor has been active in the supply of systems for reducing noise and vibration in trackwork applications and has been involved in several projects for MTR and KCRC. He is currently Strategic Business Manager, Rail Services at Tiflex, a specialist British rubber company that has been supplying the railway industry with resilient products for over 60 years.
