**Dr Yuen** is an Associate Head/ Assistant Professor in the Department of Special Education and Counselling, The Hong Kong Institute of Education. His research focus is in speech perception among children with hearing loss or other forms of listening difficulties.

This seminar will illustrate how different speech sounds are created by the generation of sound energy from the vocal folds with differential distribution of sound energy via different positioning of the structures in the vocal tract. The physiology and acoustics of phonation and the acoustic properties of various speech sounds will be presented.
