

Technical Seminar EIA for Expansion of Hong Kong International Airport into a Three-Runway System



To meet future air traffic growth, the Airport Authority Hong Kong (AAHK) has been planning to expand Hong Kong International Airport into a three-runway system (3RS). The Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Report for 3RS was approved by EPD and the Environmental Permit (EP) was granted to AAHK on 7 Nov 2014.
