Half Day Technical Visit to Macau

HKIOA is delighted to invite you to join us on a half day visit to Macau on 15 September 2023 (Friday). This will give you the excellent opportunity to explore the advanced Macau Light Rapid Transit (MLRT) 澳門輕軌系統 (Portuguese: Metro Ligeiro de Macau, MLM) and the new Galaxy International Convention Center (GICC).

The MLRT is the first operating railway system in Macau with 11 stations, providing fully automated and driverless operation on elevated guideways separated from road traffic. It uses Mitsubishi Heavy Industries Crystal Mover APM vehicles with rubber tyres, similar to the Singapore LRT, running on concrete tracks. The first phase of the project started construction in February 2012, and the first section of the Taipa line commenced service on 10 December 2019, after overcoming various challenges. It has received positive feedback from the media and the public.

The GICC of Galaxy Entertainment Group (GEG) is an exceptional venue, boasting some of the most advanced engineering features in Asia. With its cutting-edge acoustics, premium sound quality, and state-of-the-art global digital and simulcast communication capabilities, it is the perfect destination for innovative events of different scales. Furthermore, it has received Silver Certification for Environmental Design from EarthCheck, a scientific benchmarking, certification, and advisory group, placing it at the forefront of industry sustainability practices. With the kind support from GEG to facilitate this visit, this is really a unique opportunity for our members to gain the first hand and possibly the "once in a lifetime" experience of the most advanced acoustic design of the GICC.
