

Invitation

The 11th International Congress on Noise as a Public Health Problem (ICBEN 2014) will be held in Nara, Japan from June 1st to June 5th, 2014 under the auspices of the International Commission on Biological Effects of Noise with co-organization of the Institute of Noise Control Engineering of Japan and the Acoustical Society of Japan. This will be the first ICBEN Congress in Asia. The Congress venue will be Nara Prefectural New Public Hall located in the center of Nara Park surrounded by temples and shrines designated as the world cultural heritage sites.

NARA, an ancient capital of Japan The small city of Nara (population 350,000) is the capital of Nara Prefecture and about one hour away from Osaka and Kyoto by train. In the 8th century it was Japan's capital and as such has many temples and shrines that have been designated as world cultural heritage sites. The congress venue is located in one of Nara's world heritage sites. Nara is regarded as the easternmost terminal on the Silk Road, which conveyed various Western and Eastern cultures to Japan. The many statues and world heritage sites demonstrate the influence of these distant cultures: Todaiji Temple (the largest wooden building in the world), Kofukuji Temple, Toshodaiji Temple, Yakushiji Temple and Horyuji Temple (the oldest surviving wooden structure in the world and the first world heritage site in Japan). In addition to these world heritage sites, there are attractive spots and traditional townscapes near the venue such as Kasuga Taisha Shrine and Nara Machi (the historic section of Nara City).

Team 7 (Noise and animals)


Team 8 (Interactions with other agents and contextual factors)
